

Kaibab Squirrel

The Kaibab squirrel is a dark gray, tassel-eared squirrel with a white tail. They make their homes in ponderosa pine trees. The seeds found in the cones of the ponderosa are their most important source of food. When eating, a Kaibab squirrel will often curl its big bushy tail up over its back.

Kaibab squirrels are found only in a small area of ponderosa pine forests on the North Rim of the Grand Canyon and nowhere else in the world.
